Remove animals, plant life, aquariums, or cover aquariums. Shut off ventilating systems, air dusts, air conditioning and close off room or area to be treated. Extinguish all flames and pilot lights. Apply as a dry fog at the rate of 1-1/3 fluid ounces per 1,000 cubic feet of space. Direct nozzle of thermal applicator toward the upper corners of the room and along the ceiling.
