## DIRECTIONS

**PREPARATION:** Surface should be clean & dry. Remove dust, dirt, and debris using stiff brush or broom. Remove crusted rust or scaled, previous coating by scraping or wire brushing.

**COMPOSITE ROOFS:** Replace all drawn up nails with larger nails before patching. If roof is dried out, apply asphalt primer before patching.

CONCRETE ROOFS: Prime with asphalt primer before patching.

METAL ROOFS: Re-nail loose laps with longer nails to stop vibration.

APPLICATION: Apply with trowel or putty knife. Occasionally dipping trowel in mineral spirits will reduce sticking to tools.
